

## Swift Green Line Station Construction

### Weekend Lane Closures Planned on Bothell-Everett Hwy.

#### Lane Closures at Three Sites on Bothell-Everett Hwy. this Weekend

This weekend, three future *Swift* Green Line stations will receive concrete pads in the traffic lane where *Swift* buses will stop for passengers. The concrete is designed to better withstand frequent *Swift* service and reduce the need for costly maintenance in the future.

The following station sites on Bothell-Everett Hwy. will experience single-lane closures (with periodic double-lane closures) from 8 p.m. on Friday, August 17 to noon on Sunday, August 19:

- NB at 208th St. SE (pictured)
- NB at 196th St. SE
- NB at 180th St. SE

These sites may also have intermittent single-lane closures on Monday, Aug. 20 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. while crews work on curbs and sidewalks.



#### Construction Continues in Various Locations Along Route

Many sites along the route of the future *Swift* Green Line are scheduled for construction next week, from station frame installation at Seaway Transit Center to initial excavation at Canyon Park Park & Ride.

Four future stations will receive steel frames next week: two at the future Seaway Transit Center and the station pair on both sides of Airport Rd. at Hwy. 99.

Other work is scheduled Aug. 19-24 as follows, with periodic single-lane closures occurring as needed:

- **NB Bothell-Everett Hwy. at 153rd St. SE**  
Sunday night (8 p.m. to 4 a.m.)  
Curbs, sidewalks
- **SB Bothell-Everett Hwy. at 164th St. SE**  
Sunday-Tuesday night (8 p.m. to 4 a.m.)  
Sewer
- **NB Bothell-Everett Hwy. at 164th St. SE**  
Sunday night (8 p.m.) through Tuesday morning (4 a.m.)  
Curbs, sidewalks, traffic islands
- **NB Bothell-Everett Hwy. at 220th St. SE**  
Monday-Friday day (9 a.m. to 2 p.m.)  
Foundation, retaining wall
- **Canyon Park Park & Ride**  
Wednesday-Thursday night (8 p.m. to 4 a.m.)  
Excavation

## Seaway Transit Center Construction

### Swift Station Installation Begins

Crews began installing one of two *Swift* stations at the future Seaway Transit Center this week (pictured). Installation of the second station will begin next week.

Other work on-site includes irrigation, lighting, fencing and landscaping, with no road closures planned for several weeks.

### Wireless Traffic Monitor Installed

The installation of a wireless traffic monitoring system has been completed along 75th St. and on Hardeson Rd. from Merrill Creek Pkwy. to Casino Rd. The system will allow for real-time traffic monitoring and adjustments, and is expected to be operational in about a month.



### Transit Center to Open in Spring

The Seaway Transit Center will be completed this fall and open next spring with the launch of the *Swift* Green Line. In between, the facility will be tested and used for training exercises.

### Repainting Project Reaches Aurora Village

*Swift* stations along the Blue Line are being repainted this summer with a new coat of high-performance paint. The project began at the northern terminal in Everett in June and will continue at its southern terminal in Aurora Village next week.

#### Reopen on Aug. 17

- SB Hwy. 99 and 196th St. SW
- SB Hwy. 99 and 238th St. SW

#### Closed Aug. 20-24

- SB Hwy. 99 and 204th St. SW  
Catch the bus at the marked temporary stop just south of the station (see photo).
- Aurora Village Transit Center



During painting, the stations will be fenced and enclosed so the work can be done quickly and in an environmentally safe manner.

### Pay Fare at Destination

ORCA card readers and ticket vending machines will be unavailable at closed stations, so please pay your fare when you de-board.
