

Prepare for route and schedule changes

Visit communitytransit.org and select:

- **Plan My Trip** to determine the best route and schedule for you. Be sure to set the departure or arrival time to Sept. 14 or later to see the new schedule.
- **Maps & Schedules** to see the Sept. 14, 2024 preview schedule for your route.

You will find updated bus schedules at **bus stops** by Sept. 14. You may notice updated bus flags and schedules at bus stops prior to this date. Changes will not go into effect until Sept. 14.

Changes to Service

Sept. 14, 2024

Community Transit will make major changes to bus service on Sept. 14 as light rail opens in Snohomish County. Riders will have access to more transit than ever before, with expanded local and express service that connects to congestion-free light rail in Lynnwood, Mountlake Terrace, and Shoreline.

\$ New Simple Fares

Coming Sept. 1, all Community Transit routes will be \$2.50 for adults, \$1.25 for discounted fares, and kids ride free.

Connect to light rail

Upon connecting to Snohomish County on Aug. 30, light rail riders will enjoy fast, frequent, and reliable service between Lynnwood, the University of Washington, downtown Seattle, Sea-Tac Airport, and more.

Transfer seamlessly between local, express, Swift, or Zip Alderwood Shuttle service to light rail. Save on your commute with an ORCA card to take advantage of the two-hour transfer window.
