

Changes to Service

Sept. 3, 2023

Big changes are coming to Community Transit's service starting in 2024 - from connecting to light rail to reimagining our bus service to expanding our Swift bus rapid transit network.

On Sept. 3, we will change our bus schedules to prepare for those big changes and accommodate construction in our region. **We encourage all riders to check the new September 2023 route schedules (see reverse).**

On most routes, we will change the schedule slightly (by 5 to 10 minutes) on weekdays to improve connections and on-time service. We will make more significant changes on the following routes:

- **196** – More trips, returning to service every 30 minutes during peak travel times
- **113, 130, 220, & 240** – More trips. Check the route schedule for details
- **Most routes on weekends** – Significant schedule adjustments to improve connections. Be sure to check the schedule if you ride on the weekends.

How to check your route schedule

To view the new bus schedules, go to **communitytransit.org** and select:


- **Maps & Schedules** to view the updated schedule for your route. Be sure to select the planned schedules for Sept. 3.
- **Plan My Trip** to check what time the bus is scheduled so you can plan your trip accordingly. Be sure to set the departure or arrival time to Sept. 3 or later to see the new schedule.

We will post updated bus schedules at **bus stops** by Sept. 3.
