

Swift Green Line Extension



Community Transit is extending the Swift Green Line to bring fast, frequent, and reliable bus rapid transit (BRT) service to more destinations in the Bothell area. The extension will add up to nine new station pairs between Canyon Park Park & Ride, downtown Bothell, the UW Bothell/Cascadia College area, and east of I-405.

Project Timeline

- Station siting study: 2022-2024
 - Community engagement: Oct. 16 – Nov. 10, 2023
 - Recommended station locations: March 2024
- Design & Environmental Review: 2024-2027
- Tentative Construction: 2027-2030
- Service begins: As early as 2030

Stations shared with Sound Transit's Stride BRT S3 Line

Swift Green Line Extension will share three station pairs with Sound Transit's Stride S3 line in Bothell. The stations will be built by Sound Transit and provide easy transfers between transit services.

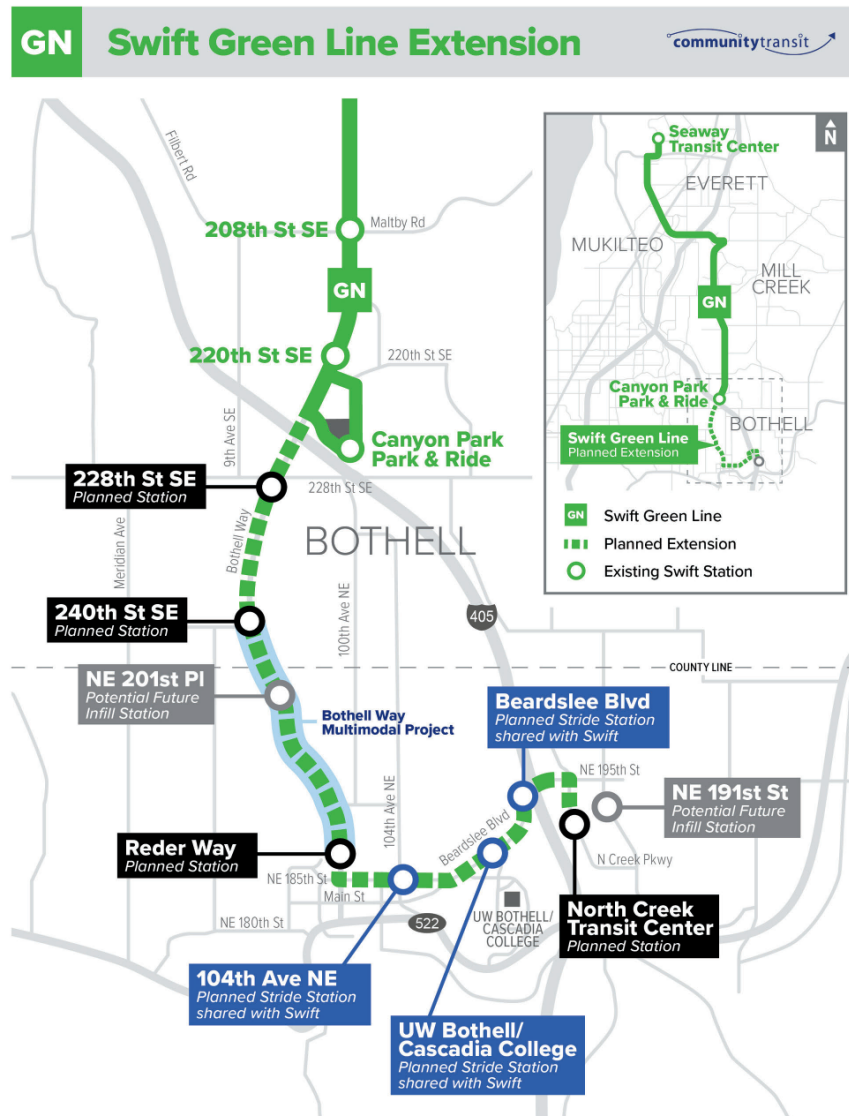
The stations will be located at:

- NE 185th St and 104th Ave NE
- Beardslee Blvd at UW Bothell/Cascadia College
- Beardslee Blvd and NE 195th St

Updated Station Design

The Swift Green Line Extension stations will feature an updated station design that includes a roof, lighting, real-time information signs, seating, windscreens, digital signage, and ticket vending machines.

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Bothell Way Multimodal Project

The Swift Green Line Extension is happening alongside the Bothell Way NE Multimodal Project, which will improve Bothell Way from Reder Way to 240th St SE, and make it easier and safer to travel by car, bike, foot, or transit in this area. This section is highlighted in light blue on the map.
